
DRAMATIC 6-YEAR DECLINE IN DEATHS RELATED TO CML

American Cancer Society reports an unprecedented decline in the number of CML-related deaths since 2001¹⁸

- 2000–2007—79% reduction in the annual death rate associated with CML
- During this time, the annual number of new CML cases remained consistent
- This overall reduction in CML-related deaths may be associated with advances in diagnosis, monitoring, and therapeutic management since 2001
